

BOROUGH OF MILFORD

SUPPLEMENTAL PROCLAMATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY TO ALL CITIZENS AND PERSONS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF MILFORD, AND TO ALL DEPARTMENTS, DIVISIONS, BUREAUS AND PERSONNEL OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE BOROUGH OF MILFORD.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers vested in me as Mayor by Chapter 251 of the laws of 1942, as amended and supplemented, N.J.S.A. App. A:9-30 et. seq.; N.J.S.A. 40:48-1(6); N.J.S.A. 2C:33- 1 et. seq.; Executive Orders 103 through 109 (2020); and Administrative Order 2020-8, I previously declared that a STATE OF EMERGENCY exists within the Borough of Milford; and

WHEREAS, the conditions and circumstances warranting the previous April 7, 2020 Proclamation declaring a STATE OF EMEGENCY continue; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid laws authorize the promulgation of such orders, rules, and regulations as may be necessary to address the various problems which have, or may be, presented by an emergency; and

WHEREAS, by reason of the ever-evolving novel coronavirus, COVID19, the State of New Jersey and the Borough of Milford recognized the need to declare a State of Emergency to ensure that the Borough's government and various departments operated without interruption; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to reduce potential risks to the Borough's employees and first responders serving the Borough as well as to mitigate factors which, absent a declaration of a State of Emergency declaration, could potentially exacerbate the rapid transmission of the COVID19 virus thereby adversely affecting the health, safety, and welfare of the Borough's employees, residents, first responders and citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Milford having declared a State of Emergency on April 7, 2020 undertook temporary precautionary measures to so protect those employees, residents and citizens within the Borough as well as the Borough's property; and

WHEREAS, the prior April 7, 2020 Borough Proclamation continues in full force and effect and this Supplemental Proclamation dated May 6, 2020, and effective as of 1200, May 5, 2020, shall serve to supplement the April 7, 2020 Borough Proclamation as to the following:

1. All Borough-sponsored recreation events are hereby cancelled until further notice (amending that all Borough sponsored recreation events were to be cancelled through the end of April 2020); and

2. Effective as of 1200 on May 5, 2020, in conjunction with New Jersey Executive Order No. 108 (2020), Paragraph 3, dated and effective March 21, 2020, and State of New Jersey, Department of Law and Public Safety, Division of New Jersey State Police Office of Emergency Management Administrative Order No. 2020-8 "Hotels, Motels, Guest Homes" dated and effective April 4, 2020 and April 5, 2020, respectively, the Borough of Milford hereby prohibits

any hotel, motel, bed and breakfast, AirBnB or VRBO, or similar online marketplace(s) which arranges for or offers lodging from accepting any new guest(s) subsequent to the effective date of this Proclamation; and

3. Penalties for any violation of this Proclamation and Executive Order No. 108 shall be imposed under N.J.S.A. App. A:9-49 and -50.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH AND PURSUANT TO the laws of the State of New Jersey and in conjunction with the State's Executive and Administrative Orders, we do hereby promulgate and declare that this Proclamation shall supplement the April 7, 2020 Proclamation to the extent that the April 7, 2020 Proclamation is inconsistent herewith; and

WE FURTHER PROCLAIM that this Supplemental Proclamation shall take effect at 1200 hours, Tuesday, May 5, 2020 and shall remain in effect until such time it is determined by me in consultation with Hunterdon County OEM Coordinator that an emergency no longer exists.
